

Family celebration

To prepare for the celebration of learning you will:

- decide on a time to hold the celebration for family members and what you will eat and drink
- make invitations to tell family members about the celebration and when to come
- tell them that you will retell one of your favourite stories for everyone to enjoy during the celebration.

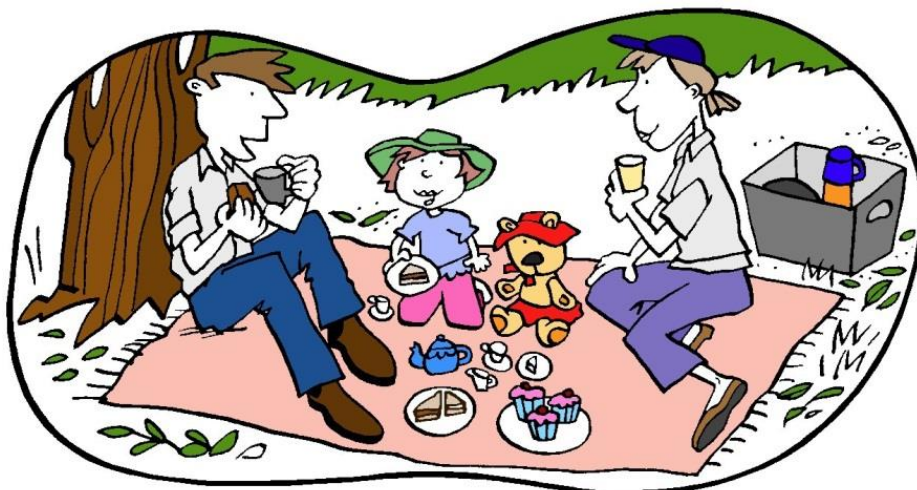


Here are some ideas for your family celebration

1. A special tea party, family barbeque or special dinner

For this celebration, you will need to think about:

- organising cooking ingredients/food/drinks, serving plates, a table, chairs or picnic rug
- making any food/drinks you need (e.g. patty cakes, sandwiches, homemade lemonade or juice, salad, sausages on a stick, damper).



2. Games night

For this celebration, you will need to think about:

- the games you will play (e.g. Snakes and Ladders, Twister, Checkers, card games)
- making any food or drinks that you need
- inviting everyone to listen to your story retell (after playing some games together).



3. Watch the sunset

For this celebration, you will need to think about:

- collecting chairs and placing them where the family can watch the sunset
- making any food or drinks that you need
- inviting everyone to listen to your story retell (as the sun goes down).
