Make it, read it, write it: Game instructions

The aim is to make, read and write words using single letters and ending letter patterns. This is a game for 2 players.

You will need

Cards cut from the **Sheet — Make it, read it, write it: Game cards**.

Three columns drawn in a scrapbook/on a piece of paper: one headed '-am', one headed '-at' and the other headed, '-ap'.

What to do

- 1. Place the single letter cards face down in a pile in the front of the players.
- 2. Place the ending letter pattern cards face up in front of the players so all the letter patterns can be seen
- 3. Players take turns to draw a single letter card from the pile and match it to one of the letter pattern cards to make a real word.
- 4. The player then reads the word and writes it in the column with the same letter pattern.
- 5. If a player cannot make a real word, they place the single letter card face down at the bottom of the pile and it is the next player's turn.
- 6. Play is finished when a player has written three words in each column.

Variations

- Players can decide if they will continue the game until all possible words have been made, read and written. (There are at least 18 real words. You can include names.)
- Single letter cards can be replaced by or added to with letter blends (for example: 'tr', 'gr', 'pr', 'sc').
- · New ending letter patterns can be added as they are introduced.
