# Simple dice games

### What you need

- 1 dice (with numbers 1 to 6 shown using dots)
- · objects to collect, e.g. 30 (or more) counters, shapes, blocks, pegs or coloured paperclips
- number cards 1 to 6 (provided on next page)
- coloured paper or card squares (to match colours of objects to be collected)

### Number game (for two or more players)

- 1. One player rolls the dice.
- 2. Collect objects to match the number on the dice, e.g. if the dice shows 5, collect five objects.
- 3. Other players roll the dice in turn and collect objects.
- 4. Each player has four turns to roll the dice.
- 5. Count how many objects each person has collected after four turns.
- 6. The winner is the person who has collected the most objects.

## Number card game (for one player)

- 1. Place the number cards 1 to 6 (provided on next page) face-up on a table.
- 2. Roll the dice.
- 3. Collect objects to match the number on the dice.
- 4. Place the collected objects near/on the number card that matches the number of objects, e.g. If you roll a 4, collect four objects and place them on or near the number 4.
- 5. The game is over when you have a set of objects to match each number (1 to 6).

#### Colour game (one or more players)

- 1. Place the coloured paper or card squares on a table.
- 2. Roll the dice.
- 3. Collect objects of **one** colour that match the number on the dice, e.g. 3 blue pegs.
- 4. Place the collected objects on the matching coloured square.
- 5. The game is over when one coloured square has 10 (or more) objects.
