Representing a farm (Answers)

For example: Students will construct a model and then explain the parts that meet the needs of living things

There is lots of fresh air all around the living things.

This is a house that gives the farmer shelter. The farmer puts his horse in a barn for shelter when the weather is bad.



The sun gives the farm warmth.

There is a water tank for the farmer to get water and the horse has a dish of water

The farmer has food in his house and he also eats the apples. The horse has grass to eat and so does the kangaroo and the emu.
